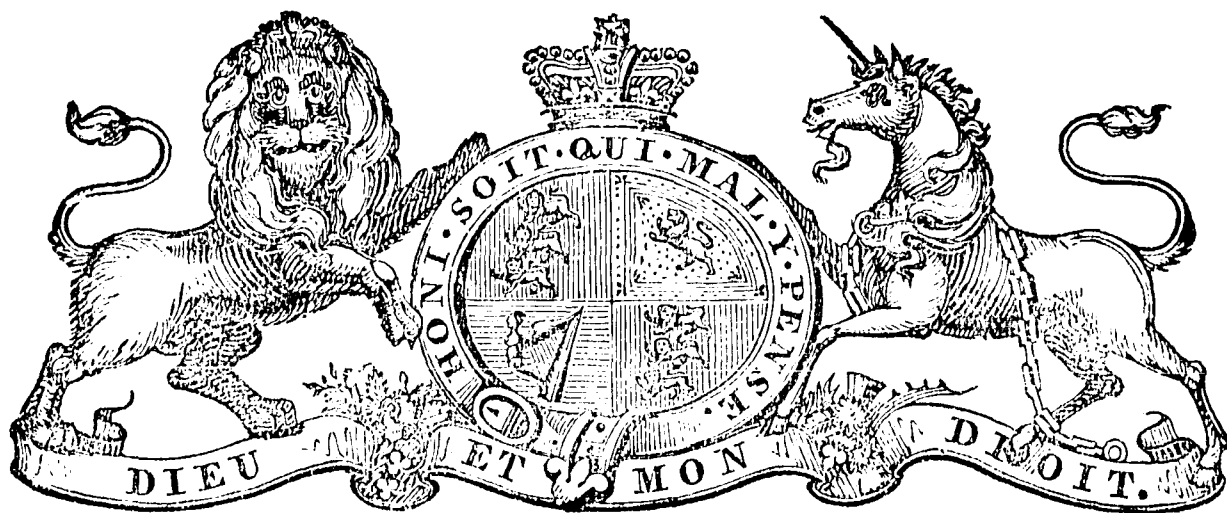

VICTORIÆ REGINÆ.

No. CXXXII.

An Act to amend an Act intituled "*An Act to consolidate and amend the Laws affecting the Chinese emigrating to or resident in Victoria.*"
[19th March, 1862.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

I. The tenth twelfth thirteenth fourteenth sixteenth and seventeenth sections of the Act of the Parliament of Victoria numbered eighty and so much of the eleventh section of the said Act as refers to yearly half-yearly and quarterly payments shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

II. No immigrant within the meaning of the said Act notwithstanding that he holds a miner's right or business license or other document under any Act now or hereafter to be in force relative to the Gold Fields shall be entitled to vote at the election of members for any Mining Board.
