An Act to amend an Act intituled "*An Act to consolidate and amend the Laws affecting the Chinese emigrating to and resident in Victoria.*" [30th June, 1863.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend an Act passed in the twenty-second year of the reign of Her present Majesty and numbered eighty intituled "*An Act to consolidate and amend the laws affecting the Chinese emigrating to or resident in Victoria*" Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows :

Preamble

The operation of the fifth seventh eighth ninth and fifteenth sections of the said Act and so much of the eleventh section as was not repealed by the Act of the Parliament of Victoria, numbered CXXXII. shall be and the same are hereby suspended for the term of two years.
